

OUR LADY OF PERPETUAL HELP SCHOOL
REGISTRATION 2010-2011

- Registration for returning students is set for January 25 - 29.
- Registration for new students is set for February 22 - 26.
- OLPH can not guarantee a place for any existing student who registers after February 22. Registration for existing students will be processed only for families who are up-to-date in current tuition payments.
- There is a **non-refundable** registration fee of \$165 for 1st child and \$150 for any additional children.
- The following is required to complete (new) registration:
 - A. Birth Certificate
 - B. Social Security Number
 - C. Baptismal Certificate
 - D. Health Certificate
 - **4 DTP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis)**
 - **3 Polio doses provided the last dose was administered on or after age 4.**
 - **2 MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) doses after the 1st birthday.**
 - **Hepatitis B vaccination (3 doses) is a Pre-K and Kindergarten entry requirement.**
 - **Varicella (chicken pox) vaccination required or documentation of the disease.**
 - E. The last report card and standardized test scores (where applicable.)
- **Tuition for School Year 2010-2011**
 - **Kindergarten - 8th grade** for Parish-Supporting Catholics
 - 1 student \$3,450.00
 - 2 students \$6,037.50
 - 3 students \$7,762.50
 - 4 students or more \$8,625.00
 - **Tuition for Pre-K 3 and Pre-K 4 is \$3,600** (including school supplies). Pre-K students do not qualify for multi-student discounts.
 - **Other Fees for 2010-2011** Non-Parish Support fee \$300 per child (see reverse of form for information about Parish/Non-Parish fees)
- **Optional fee:** Extended Care fees per child:
 - Daily or Drop in: \$2.00 A.M., \$5.00 P.M. – till 6:00
 - Yearly: \$300 A.M. \$810 P.M.
 - Both A.M. & P.M. \$1,100 (1 child) \$1700 (2 or more children)
- Tuition may be paid in full by July 1, 2010 or may be financed through First Bank and Trust over 10 months beginning July 1, 2010.

The Non-Parish Fee is mandated by the Archdiocese to all children who do not qualify as registered, active and supporting parishioners. Catholic students who come from Parishes with no school, or with schools who have no room in the appropriate grade, should contact their Pastors to obtain a “Voucher”. Archdiocesan Policy mandates that Non-Parishioner students who register without a Voucher be assessed the Non-Parish Fee.

A parishioner of Our Lady of Perpetual Help is one who is registered, active and supporting. This means the family has filled out the Parish census form, is in regular attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days, and is a regular financial contributor to the Parish. Parishioner status must be certified by the Parish Office.
